ENGINEERING DIRECTORATE CHANGES

To reflect the changes made in Engineering Directorate the Senior Management structure will be re-organised as follows:

The post of Deputy Director of Engineering will be closed and Charlie Sandbank will assume the responsibility of Assistant to Director of Engineering. His work will include handling the BBC's engineering rôle in the EBU, continuing his existing work within the EUREKA and RACE projects, and such other projects nominated by Director of Engineering as they arise.

Bert Gallon at present Chief Engineer Transmission will take on, in addition to the transmission role, the management responsibilities of Architectural and Civil Engineering Department, Information Technology Engineering and Engineering Computer Services. He will be based in London, and will act as Director of Engineering's Deputy. The new post will be titled Chief Engineer Transmission and Project Services.

Phil Laven at present Chief Engineer Information and Training will assume, in addition to the Engineering and Equipment Departments, the new Head Design titled Chief Engineer Research and Development.

All these changes will be effective from 1st January 1991.
